




## **Silver Dressings Pathway**

Is the wound infected/critically colonised/MRSA positive? Check for signs of infection such as:

Redness, swelling, pain, pus, odour






## Apply formulary silver dressing.

Choice should be guided by the amount of exudate present and the level of infection. Please use correct dressing size to correspond with wound size. Dressings can be cut to size.




## Apply non-silver formulary dressing.
